ABOUT GIFT AID

By using Gift Aid, the British Friends of Vanuatu Charitable Trust is able to claim extra tax from the Revenue & Customs Department for every pound you give, helping your donations go further at no extra cost to you. The present rate of tax means this is worth an additional £2.50 for every £10 donated.

The basis on which you pay UK tax is not important. This includes income tax, tax deducted from bank or building society interest, the tax credit on dividends from UK companies or other capital gains tax. For example, if you donate £15 a year to the charity, to make your gift eligible for for Gift Aid you must have paid at least £3.75 in tax. If you pay tax at higher rate, you can claim further tax relief in your self-assessment tax return. A gift aid declaration can be given in writing, either by post or facsimile or by email.

You can cancel your declaration at any time by notifying us - for example, if your circumstances change and you must do so if you no longer pay UK income tax or you change your name or address.
