## BFoV Breaking News

As at August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024

Following decisions made at the 2024 Annual General Meeting of the association held in Weymouth, Dorset, on 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2024, the British Friends of Vanuatu and the British Friends of Vanuatu Charitable Trust are to be wound up with effect from 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2024.

Thereafter, in accordance with the decision of the Weymouth AGM, once all financial obligations have been met, the balance of charitable funds will be donated to the Wilkins Family Foundation – an Australian educational charity operating in Vanuatu.

Full details of the proposed changes have been reported to the membership in the association newsletter, Nabanga, and further details will be reported in the final two issues of the newsletter distributed to the membership in October 2024 and January 2025.

Accordingly, no further national meetings of the BFoV will be organised by the association prior to closure on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2024.
